

STATUTE OF THE AUTOMOTIVE CLUB EUROCONTROL (ACE)

Article 1 – Status

The Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE) club is organised within the remit of The International Association of EUROCONTROL Staff (A.I.P.E.).

The club shall promote and facilitate the theory and practice of safe and responsible motorsport and the culture of classic and sports cars within the EUROCONTROL community and, when feasible and appropriate within the international and EU civil servants community.

The club shall establish contacts with the appropriate Belgian and International organisations governing the motorsport and classic cars activities (e.g. FBVA, RACB, etc) in order to get recognition and to provide cooperation

The club can organize occasionally events, both internal and open to the general public and coaching, in both technical and sports domain.

Article 2 – Management of the Association

The Members of the Association elect every two years:

Obligatory statutory roles:

1. A President
2. A Vice president (generally the most voted of the non-elected candidates to the presidency)
3. A Treasurer

Complementary roles:

4. A Secretary
5. One or more focal points for "Technical matters and car certification"
6. One or more focal points for "Motorsport rules and pilot licensing"

The members elected at the above posts constitutes the "Committee"

The "Committee" can invite other members to its meetings or delegate tasks thereto.

Article 3 – Members

The Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE) shall be open to all EUROCONTROL officials and their dependents and also to the temporary staff (contractor/interim/seconded). Non-Eurocontrol related persons, upon invitation of a Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE) member or by spontaneous application may be accepted as well subject to agreement by the committee and, ideally, not exceeding 25% of the total members. The Committee also reserves the right to exclude any participant who fails to comply with the obligations set out in these Regulations, or whose behaviour endangers others.

Article 4 - Budget

The Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE) shall be financed entirely by AIPE subsidies, members' subscriptions, contributions from paying guests and sponsorships.

The AIPE subsidy shall be paid annually and the amount shall vary in line with the AIPE budget and the number of EUROCONTROL officials who are members of the Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE).

The membership subscription fee shall be determined per calendar year by the Committee, which shall also set the contribution fee for each activity to be paid by the members and by paying guests.

Members' subscriptions shall be paid annually in December upon registration before the beginning of the new season in January. The amount will be announced through the Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE) membership subscription form. On no account shall the subscription / contribution or part thereof, be reimbursed. The contributions related to the club activities themselves will be determined on ad-hoc basis.

Article 5 – Sickness and accident cover

EUROCONTROL officials and their dependants are covered, under Rule of Application No.10 of the Staff Regulations concerning sickness and accident insurance. Paying guests and temporary Eurocontrol staff are not covered thereby and they will be requested to provide other proof of coverage.

Article 6 – Liabilities

Members participate in the club activities at their own risk. The Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE) shall not be held liable for any loss, damage or injury to participants resulting from an accident in the course of the motorist activities or from loss, theft of, damage to the participants' property.

Article 7 - Corporate values and code of sportsmanship

The AIPEurocontrol Automotive Club Eurocontrol (ACE) members are bound to the applicable EUROCONTROL corporate values and to the general code of sportsmanship, showing safety orientation, courtesy, dignity and fair play.

Their behaviour towards outsiders shall not be detrimental to EUROCONTROL's image.

Article 8 – Seat of the club

The official seat of the club is located in the AIPEUROCONTROL premises, c/o EUROCONTROL, Rue de la Fusee 96 – B1040 Haren
